

Special Interest Group (SIG) Personalised and Precision Medicine

In 2023, Personalised and Precision Medicine (PPM) SIG continued to contribute to relevant FIP programmes as detailed below.

• Co-organized and co-hosted Precision Medicine webinars series with the FIP Technology Forum. Between 2022-2023, the PPM SIG joined force with the FIP Technology Forum to organize and hosted a series of 3 set of webinars focusing on Precision Medicine. These webinars were well attended by an average of around 600 people per webinar. PPM SIG chair served as co-chair and speaker for the first webinar on 4/21/2022 (Precision Medicine: the Current status). PPM SIG chair also co-chaired and served as a moderator for the second (10/5/2022) and third (2/7/2023) webinar. The third webinar entitled "Precision Medicine: What Will it Cost?" had a record number of registrars of almost 800 people from around the world.

This is the <u>one</u> <u>activity our SIG</u> is particularly proud of, because it enhanced the unique position of FIP as a global organisation for both scientists and pharmacists.
