

**Prof. Olivier Bugnon**, born in 1964 (Fribourg, Switzerland), graduated as a pharmacist from the University of Lausanne in 1988. He obtained his PhD in Neuropharmacology from the University of Geneva (1994) and his postgraduate FPH Diploma of Specialist in Community Pharmacy Practice (2003).
